Functions of the General Assembly

- ☑ Upon proposal of the Board, it appoints the Director-General by secret ballot
- ☑ It elects the members of the Council
- ☑ and the members of the Finance and Audit Committee (FAC)
- ☑ It reviews and **approves ICCROM's biennial program of activities and budget** on the basis of proposals made to it by the Council
- ☑ It determines the contributions of the Member States
- ☑ It reviews and **approves reports on the activities of the ICCROM Council and Secretariat**
- ☑ It decides on the admission of new Member States - if they are non-Member States of UNESCO - and on the readmission of old Member States
- ☑ It decides on the application of the sanctions provided for in Article 9
- ☑ **It approves proposals for amendments to the Statutes emanating from the Council or the Member States.**

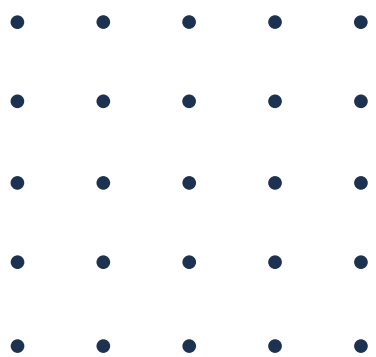
Finance & Audit Committee

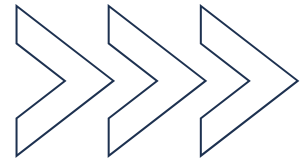
Advises the Council on matters related to the financial administration

Composed of up to 6 representatives of Member States, President and Vice President of the Council in charge of Finance and Administration

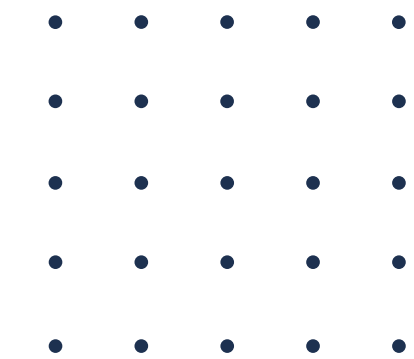
The members of the Committee are elected by the General Assembly

Current members are from: China, Dominican Republic, India, Japan, United States

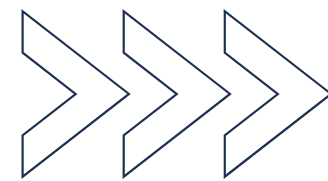




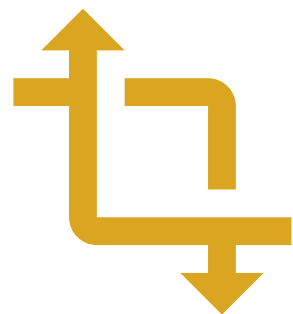
