

Factsheet: "The restoration and critical reconstruction of Al Nouri Mosque and its Al-Hadba Minaret"

- Implementing Organization: UNESCO
- <u>Duration of project:</u> 5 years
- Budget of project: \$50.4 million
- <u>Scope of project:</u>
 - o Reconstruction of Al-Hadba Minaret and its base
 - Reconstruction of Al Nouri Mosque and adjacent buildings (like the office and house of the Imam, storage, and other necessary spaces for the mosque)
 - $\circ~$ Rebuilding the infrastructure and historic gardens around the mosque
 - Building a memorial site (or museum) to contain remnants and history of the mosque with community and educational spaces

- <u>Roles and Responsibilities of Technical Committee:</u>
 - \circ Discuss matters that require input from the local government in Iraq, society, and the experts
 - o Will include a sub-committee called "Scientific Committee" to discuss detailed technical matters
- Additional Information:
 - It is estimated that the project will provide 1000 training and employment opportunities for Iraqis during the implementation of the project
 - \circ The project is expected to generate economic benefits, especially from cultural tourism
