The Forum is open to all students who are about to graduate or have recently graduated, PhD students, researchers, and professionals in the field of Cultural Heritage, e.g. conservators, restorers, art historians, architects, conservation scientists, registrars, museologists, archaeologists, etc.

STRUCTURE

This year's Forum consists of a series of integrated events and activities to improve the participants' professional skills and expand their international networks.

REGISTRATION

Open from January 17^{th} , 2022, with the possibility to apply for scholarships.

SCHOLARSHIP

Students or early career practicing conservators and scientists currently engaged in either a public or a private capacity located in emerging economies, such as South America and the Caribbean, Africa, and South East Asia, can participate in the IIC scholarship selection.

Scholarships sponsored by Amici del CCR are available to graduates or undergraduates of the university degree in Conservation of Cultural Heritage at the University of Turin and the Centro Conservazione e Restauro "La Venaria Reale" (CCR). Scholarships are also offered to North-Macedonian young professionals under the Central European Initiative (CEI) Know-how Exchange Programme (KEP) 2021.

FELLOWSHIP

The most outstanding profile is awarded a fellowship at the CCR, sponsored by Fondazione Magnetto.
