Greater transparency

Clearer, easier and more understandable information on data processing. I know how my data is processed and I can exercise my rights

Rights of interested parties

Rights to information, access, withdrawal of consent, opposition to treatment, rectification, restriction of processing and erasure

Being forgotten and portability

The possibility to erase information online that jeopardizes privacy, and to transfer data from one data controller to another

Data breach

Clear procedures in the event of a breach that may impact personal information (accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorized disclosure of or access to personal data)

Security measures Activities and fulfilments carried out to ensure the

reduction of risks deriving from data processing

Roles and responsibilities

Identification of roles and responsibilities of those who handle personal data

Commitment to enforce compliance with data
protection principles, both internally by staff
and externally by third parties with whom
