Criteria for Selecting the Participants for 2015

The participants for the course would be selected on the basis of following criteria:

- ✓ Number of Participants: Total number of 16 participants would be selected for this course, which would include 8 participants from disaster management or relevant fields and 8 participants from cultural heritage conservation field.
- ✓ The course organizers shall bear basic necessary costs for the participation of selected participants from developing countries. For list of developing countries please visit the following link; <u>http://www.oecd.org/dac/stats/documentupload/DAC%20List%20of%200DA%20Recipients%202014%20final.pdf</u>
- ✓ Participants from developed countries may also be accepted for the course provided they are selected through general application process and agree to cover their own costs for attending the course. Please refer course costs for details.
- ✓ Efficiency in training Implementation: It is expected that the participants from the cultural heritage field as well as disaster management field would work together during the course.
- ✓ Case Study Site: Each participant will select one case study site in his or her own country. The cultural heritage site should be vulnerable to one or more natural hazards such as earthquake and/or fire and/or flood and/or landslide.
- ✓ **Multiplying effect:** It would be preferable if the participant is attached to a cultural heritage or disaster management department/organization/university, through which knowledge gained during the course can be disseminated at local/national or regional level.

Working language

The working language of the course will be English. Proficiency in the written and spoken English is an essential prerequisite for participation.



Course Costs

There is no tuition fee for the course even for the participants from developed countries.

For the participants from Developing Countries (please refer to the URL for the definition: <u>http://www.oecd.org/dac/stats/documentupload/DAC%20List%20of%20ODA%20Recipients%202014%20final.pdf</u>), the organizer of the course will cover below.

- ✓ Most economical round trip travel cost from the nearest airport that to and from Kyoto
- ✓ Basic living costs including basic accommodation and meals
- ✓ Domestic transportation cost in Japan.

For the selected participants from Developed Countries are expected to cover their round trip travel cost to and from Kyoto, and 250,000JPY (at the current exchange rate 2,100USD around) for basic living cost and domestic transportation cost in Japan.

The participants will be strictly required to follow the provisions governing expenses of Ritsumeikan University. Any extra claim cannot be accepted.

Selection Process

Those interested in attending the course are invited to submit their application by filling the enclosed form and other necessary documentation as requested and send these by email on or before April 9th, 2015 (please visit section on application requirements). Based on the submitted applications, the applicants would be shortlisted.

Final selection would be made through telephonic interview of shortlisted applicants. The dates for these interviews would be informed later.


